COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

FEBRUARY 19, 2014

(The regular monthly meeting scheduled for February 12, 2014 was moved to February 19 due to inclement weather)

ATTENDANCE

Present: Mayor William C. Collins, and council members Walter Bailey, Aaron Brown, Kima Garten-Schmidt, Bob Jackson and Bill McIntosh. Terry Jenkins was absent. Also present were Lisa Wallace, Director of Administrative Services & Clerk-Treasurer and G.W. Parker, Town Attorney. Members of the press and the public were duly notified of the meeting and were also present.

CALL TO ORDER

The regular monthly meeting of Summerville Town Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 19, 2014 in Council Chambers. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mr. Brown, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mayor Collins called for any comments from the citizens. Dora Ann Reaves of 557 Simmons Avenue and member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church thanked members of the Summerville Fire Department for their assistance during the recent ice storm. Mr. Louis Smith with the Community Resource Center thanked Mayor Collins for accepting the invitation to attend a Town Hall meeting at Doty Field to discuss issues that are important to their community. There being no further comments offered, the Mayor declared that portion of the meeting closed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Mr. Jackson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brown, to approve the minutes of the January 8, 2014 Council meeting as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Bailey made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jackson, to approve the February 10, 2014 Finance Committee Report; the February 6, 2014 Planning and Development Committee Report; and the February 6, 2014 Public Works Committee Report as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

PETITIONS

Mr. McIntosh made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jackson, to accept the petition and have first reading of an ordinance to annex Dorchester County TMS #136-07-05-082 located on Central Avenue and owned by Camellia Heights, LP to be zoned B-2 "Neighborhood Business Center". The motion carried unanimously.

PENDING BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

Ms. Garten-Schmidt made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jackson, to have second and final reading of an ordinance to amend Chapter 28 of the Code of Laws of the Town of Summerville to prohibit through trucks along S. Gum Street and S. Magnolia Street. The motion carried unanimously.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

Mr. Jackson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brown, to adopt a Resolution thanking students from area schools for designing and painting the mural behind the Summerville/Dorchester Museum. The motion carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS

There were no miscellaneous items to discuss.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Brown made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Garten-Schmidt, to enter into executive session at 7:49 p.m. to discuss legal matters related to an easement along the sawmill branch canal. Council returned to public session at 8:15 p.m. and announced that no action was taken.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:16 p.m.
