COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES MARCH 13, 2013

ATTENDANCE

Present: Mayor William C. Collins and Council members Walter Bailey, Aaron Brown, Kima Garten-Schmidt, Bob Jackson and Bill McIntosh. Mayor Pro Tem Terry Jenkins was absent. Also present were Lisa Wallace, Director of Administrative Services & Clerk-Treasurer and G.W. Parker, Town Attorney. Members of the press and the public were duly notified of the meeting and were also present.

CALL TO ORDER

The regular monthly meeting of Summerville Town Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 13, 2013 in Council Chambers. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mr. Jackson, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENTATIONS

Mayor Collins announced the first item on the agenda was the presentation of a resolution honoring Mr. Fred Weathers for providing the citizens of Summerville a beautiful rose garden on N. Main Street for many years. Ms. Wallace read the resolution and Mayor Collins called for a motion. Mr. Jackson made the motion, seconded by Mr. Brown, to adopt the resolution as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Jim Sitler, a representative of the Robynwyn crime watch community, thanked council for the recent installation of lights and crime watch signs in the Robynwyn community.

Charlie Cuzzell, a member of the Board of Directors for the Summerville Dorchester Chamber of Commerce, read a letter from Chairman Nancyjean Nettles commending Council members for their fiscal responsibility in saving \$550,000 in taxpayer dollars by paying off the debt for the parking garage early.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Mr. McIntosh made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jackson, to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2013 Council meeting and the March 11, 2013 Finance Committee meeting as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

PETITIONS

Mayor Collins announced that no petitions were submitted.

PENDING BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

Mr. Jackson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bailey, to have second and final reading of an ordinance to annex to TMS #'s 130-13-00-081, 130-13-00-082 and 130-09-00-007 located at 312, 314 and 414 N. Maple Street and owned by Kapstone Charleston Kraft, LLC to be zoned I 2 "Industrial". The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Brown made a motion, seconded by Ms. Garten-Schmit, to have second and final reading of an ordinance to rezone TMS #130-15-03-010 located at 605 W. 5th N. Street from R2 "Single Family Residential" to B2 "Neighborhood Business Centers". The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Collins announced that there were no new bills or resolutions.

MISCELLANEOUS

Mayor Collins announced that there were no miscellaneous items to present.

ADJOURN

Mr. McIntosh made a motion to adjourn the meeting in memory of his friend and neighbor, Jacob Webb, a senior engineering major at Clemson University who recently passed away. Ms. Garten-Schmidt seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:37 p.m.
