





Project Mapping and Typical Sections

About the Project

The Town of Summerville is studying improvements to North Maple Street from south of the Parsons Road/West Richardson Avenue intersection to the North Maple Street Extension that is being constructed as part of the Nexton Interchange Project. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic operations in order to meet future traffic demands on North Maple Street and Parsons Road.

Project Description

The main elements of the project include:

- From Parsons Road to West Richardson Avenue, extend North Maple Street to Parsons Road and create a four leg intersection at West Richardson Avenue.
- From West Richardson Avenue to US Route 78 widen North Maple Street to include a center turn lane.
- From US Route 78 to North Maple Street Extension widen North Maple Street to include four through lanes and a center turn lane.
- Accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians along the project.
- Proposed typical sections can be found inside of this handout.


