Town Facilities To Close Early Thursday Ahead Of Possible Severe Weather

SUMMERVILLE, S.C. (Wednesday, March 17, 2021) – All Summerville Town facilities will close at 12 p.m., noon, on Thursday, March 18, 2021, due to the possibility of severe weather forecasted by the [National Weather Service](#). The closure includes Town buildings, parks, and athletic fields. The regularly scheduled March Design Review Board meeting has been postponed to a later date to be determined. Municipal Court operations will proceed as scheduled Thursday morning.

Collection services with Carolina Waste are scheduled to begin at 6 a.m. Thursday and expected to be completed at 2 p.m. Scheduled changes will be posted to the Town website.

Flooded roadways and downed trees can be reported to the non-emergency dispatch line at (843) 875-1650.

Downed power lines and power outages should be reported to utility providers.
